For control of tar spot (*Phyllachora maydis*) apply 13.7 fl oz/A of Miravis Neo either as an early application timing at the V4-V8 growth stages or apply 13.7 fl oz/A as a late-season application at the VT/R1 growth stages. Under heavy disease pressure or if conditions are favorable for disease, apply 13.7 fl oz/A of Miravis Neo both as an early and late-season application.

Do not make more than two applications of Miravis Neo or other Group 7, 3, or 11 fungicides before alternation with a fungicide that is not in Group 7, 3, or 11.

Follow all other directions for use, restrictions and precautions given on the Miravis Neo Section 3 label.
