### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

CROSSHAIR<sup>®</sup> is specially formulated for use with most fungicides, herbicides and insecticides that are labeled for use in agriculture, forestry, golf course, industrial, non-crop, roadside, turf, and ornamentals. CROSSHAIR is a deposition and drift management agent that reduces the number of spray droplet fines < 105 microns and increases the VMD (Volume Median Diameter) of the spray droplets. CROSSHAIR generates a more uniform droplet size spectrum which results in enhanced deposition and coverage of the spray on the targeted surface.

NOTE: CROSSHAIR does not replace the need for additional adjuvants/surfactants in the spray tank.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Rate: Use 4 fluid ounces of CROSSHAIR per acre.

#### **MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### CROSSHAIR must be added to the spray tank last.

When water conditioning products are used, always add the water conditioning product as the first product in the spray mixture.

Add any additional adjuvants to the spray tank before CROSSHAIR.

Proper nozzle selection and operation (pressure and spray angle) combined with good operator evaluation and decision making on wind direction, temperature inversions, application speed and susceptible crops in the area combined with CROSSHAIR are necessary for maximum drift reduction potential.

For pesticides that permit the use of a surfactant at a higher rate, follow instructions on that pesticide label. HOWEVER, DO NOT ADD THIS PRODUCT AT A RATE WHICH EXCEEDS 5% OF THE FINISHED SPRAY VOLUME. Use caution at the higher use rates. When applying to a sensitive crop, first treat a small area to determine if there are any adverse effects to the crop.

Aquatic Use (Not for Use in Washington): CROSSHAIR can be used with labeled aquatic products. Do not exceed 1 quart of CROSSHAIR per surface acre of water.
